**Re: BOCES Inclement Weather Procedures**

**School Closure:** If Mount Sinai School District is closed due to inclement weather, there will be no transportation provided to BOCES by the district, regardless of whether or not BOCES is open. Student absences from BOCES on these dates will be excused. If BOCES is closed due to inclement weather but Mount Sinai is open, students will be picked up at home between 10:30 and 11:00 to be transported to the high school for the start of 6<sup>th</sup> period at 11:10am.

**2 Hour Delayed Opening:** If Mount Sinai is operating on a 2-hour delayed schedule, there will be no transportation provided to BOCES by the district, regardless of whether or not BOCES is open. Student absences from BOCES on these dates will be excused. BOCES students will be picked up at home by the district buses between 11:15 and 11:45 to be transported to the high school for the start of 6<sup>th</sup> period at 12 pm. If BOCES is operating on a 2-hour delay, the morning classes would be cancelled at BOCES so no transportation is needed.

**Early Release:** If Mount Sinai releases students early due to inclement weather, the students from BOCES will return to the high school first, then be transported home on their normal afternoon bus at the time of early release.

\*Please note that these procedures are in place for the most common changes related to inclement weather. On other scheduled dates where there is a discrepancy between BOCES and Mount Sinai (BOCES open, Mount Sinai closed or BOCES closed, Mount Sinai open) we will send a notice home to BOCES students explaining the procedure for the date in question.
