Dear Parents and Guardians:

As you may know, the Mount Sinai School District may utilize the implementation of a two-hour delayed opening in the event inclement weather precludes the safe arrival of our students to school at the normal time. Additionally, we may utilize an early dismissal in the event inclement weather hinders the safe departure of our students from school at the normal time. Please see the procedures listed below for both of these scenarios which will be communicated via the School Messenger system. Please make sure that School Messenger accounts have accurate contact information in order to receive school notifications. You may do so by visiting our District webpage and by clicking on the School Messenger tab in the Parents/Community area.

DELAYED OPENING PROCEDURES

- The start of school will be delayed for two hours. The High School day will begin at 9:20 a.m.
- Students are to report to their bus stop two hours after their regularly scheduled pick-up time. For example, a student scheduled for a 6:50 a.m. pick-up time should expect to be picked up at approximately 8:50 a.m.
- Morning extra help and before school activities will be cancelled during a two-hour delayed opening.
- Students will report to their period 1 classes upon arrival and follow the abbreviated bell schedule (attached). All class and lunch periods will meet if a two-hour delayed opening is utilized.
- Students will not attend regularly scheduled AM BOCES programs. Please see additional information (attached) about the BOCES Inclement Weather Procedures.

EARLY DISMISSAL PROCEDURES

- Students will be supervised and dismissed via our early dismissal plan as each bus arrives.
- All afterschool activity and evening activities scheduled will be cancelled if an early dismissal has been
 implemented. This includes, but is not limited to: Interscholastic athletics, extracurricular activities, concerts and
 building use requests.
