Dear Class of 2025 Parents/Guardians:

At the end of the first semester, we will begin extending parking privileges to current juniors with a <u>Class D driver's license</u>. Juniors who qualify will be entered into a lottery to receive an assigned parking spot in our student lot. Only a limited number of permits will be issued on a first come basis, as spots have already been assigned to members of our current senior class. Before a student-parking permit is issued, each student must meet the list of requirements below:

Class D License

Student drivers must present a valid Class D Driver's License.

Distracted Driving Awareness Program

In effort to better educate, prepare and encourage our students to practice safe driving routines, all students requesting a school-issued parking permit will be required to participate in a mandatory Distracted Driving Awareness program with their parent or guardian prior to being issued a parking permit. A parent or guardian must attend with their child. Given the importance of the content, there will be no exceptions to this requirement. This presentation is scheduled twice throughout the school year; once in January and again in August. The next presentation will be held on Tuesday, January 23rd at 7:00 p.m. A registration link and more information has been posted to the high school website.

Registration & Insurance

Student drivers must provide copies of valid registration and automobile insurance card for the vehicle which they will be driving. If a student drives a different vehicle, copies of registration and insurance must be submitted for that vehicle.

Rules and Regulations

Parents and student drivers must sign the Robert M. Grable Mount Sinai High School Parking Rules and Regulation agreement. Violations of the rules and/or observation of driving behavior that is deemed unsafe or inappropriate by administration will result in suspension or revocation of parking privileges.

Students requesting a parking permit for the remainder of the current school year, must complete and submit the forms on pages 3-4 of the attached packet, and include copies of all required documents. Completed applications should be submitted to the main office. The lottery for junior permits will take place on Friday, January 26th and permits will be effective beginning on Monday, January 29th.

Senior Parking Permits for the 2024-25 school year will once again be issued at the *Senior Parking Lottery Breakfast*, which will be held on in August 2024. Students who submit completed documents this year will not need to resubmit documents, and will have their name automatically entered in next year's lottery.

Robert M. Grable Mount Sinai High School Rules & Regulations for Driving with a Class D License

- Student Drivers must present a valid Class D driver's license, car registration and a valid automobile insurance card at the time of permit registration.
- All students requesting a parking permit must attend a mandatory Distracted Driving Awareness presentation with a parent/guardian. There will be no exception to this requirement.
- Students must exercise extreme caution when entering and exiting the parking area. Excessive speed and/or reckless driving is prohibited and may result in revocation of driving privileges.
- Under no circumstances may a student go to his/her car during the school day.
- Students may only park in their assigned parking spots
- The parking permit sticker must be adhered to the rear windshield of the registered automobile so that it is clearly visible.
- All New York State traffic rules and regulations pertaining to driving and auto maintenance will be in effect.
- All drivers are expected to yield to school buses. School buses always have the "right of way".
- Student drivers must use the North Country Road entrance when entering and exiting the school district grounds. Students observed violating this expectation will have their parking privileges suspended.
- Excessive or repeated lateness to school and/or cutting class will result in suspension or loss of driving privileges.
- Violations of the above stated rules and regulations and/or observations of driving behavior that is deemed unsafe or inappropriate by administration will result in suspension or revocation of perking privileges.
